- * I cup confectioners' sugar
- * I carton (8 oz.) frozen whipped topping,thawed (3 cups)
- * I can (21 oz.) cherry pie filling

DIRECTIONS

- * In a bowl, combine the graham cracker crumbs, confectioners' sugar and butter.

 Press onto the bottom of a 8-in square pan.
- * In a large bowl, beat cream cheese and
 confectioners' sugar until smooth; fold in
 whipped topping. Spread over crust.
 Spoon pie filling over top. Refrigerate until
